
Cookie Policy

Our website uses cookies and according to the law of electronic communication we need to inform you of this. A cookie is a small text file stored on your computer and Expando AB (www.expando.se) uses cookies to improve the website functionality for users.

How to disable cookies

If you do not want to store any cookies on your computer, you can disable this function in your web browser settings. The way to do this varies between different browsers and you can find specific instructions on your web browser's help page. Disabling cookies means that many functions on the website will not work for you.

Regarding privacy and cookies on this website

Expando AB does not store any personal details in the cookies, just information that allow all our services to work as intended during your visit (session) at our website. New cookies with new values will be created on your next visit and we only use permanent cookies to store user settings, not identifiable or personal data. Please see our privacy policy for more information.

Different kinds of cookies

There are two different types of cookies that are used for different purposes, called permanent cookies and session cookies.

A permanent cookie stores a text file on the device that you are using to visit the website. This file is stored and used on each subsequent visit to the website and can be read and written to by the website on several occasions. Usages for permanent cookies are for instance to keep your personal user settings active on the website for a longer period of time.

Session cookies are used to identify logged in users and to provide them with the correct authorizations. A session cookie is created during a visit to the website and is only saved in the device's memory for as long as the web browser is running. A session cookie can, among other things, be used to certify that the same user is doing all the different steps when registering housing for subleasing as an example.

Expando AB uses the following cookies:

1. iGoMoon moon_cookie is being stored in the browser once the user has accepted the use of cookies.
